- Since 2000, Humble ISD campuses have received over *\$6.74 million dollars* from the Foundation.
- In the 2013-2014 school year to date, the Foundation has awarded **\$1,025,724** in grants.
 - **\$271,082** were awarded on Prize Posse day
 - **\$754,642** were awarded in designated grants throughout the school year
- **149** projects on forty-three campuses were awarded a grant from the Foundation during the 2013-2014 school year (92 on Prize Posse day).
